

## Welcome to AirTrain JFK.

AirTrain JFK is the affordable, quick, eco-friendly way to travel to and from Kennedy International Airport.

AirTrain JFK runs 24 hours a day, every day and provides easy connections with MTA New York City Transit subways and buses, and the Long Island Rail Road (LIRR).

AirTrain costs just \$5 with a Pay-Per-Ride MetroCard as you enter or exit the system at the Jamaica or Howard Beach stations. Children under 5 ride free. MTA and LIRR fares are not included.

And the service is fast—AirTrain makes a complete loop from the Jamaica or Howard Beach stations around the airport in less than 20 minutes.

AirTrain is free for travel anywhere on the airport.

### Traveler's Tips

In little more than 30 minutes, you can be in Manhattan with AirTrain JFK and the LIRR.

Travel to Jamaica Station and purchase an AirTrain/LIRR combination ticket to leave the system. Follow the signs to the LIRR train and in about 35 minutes, you'll arrive at Penn Station in midtown Manhattan.

LIRR ticket machines accept cash (U.S. currency only), credit cards, and debit cards. The machines return up to \$17.75 in change (in coins).


